# Does Life really exist?

The inability of scientists to agree on a definition of Life suggests one of the following is true:


- 1. There is no such thing as Life, i.e. the distinction is entirely arbitrary it is whatever we choose it to be. Hence, there is no right answer to the question What is Life?
- 2. There is such a thing as Life, i.e. there is a correct answer, which does draw a clear and meaningful distinction, and:
  - a) The difference between a living thing and a non-living thing is due to something supernatural (e.g. God, soul), which cannot be explained scientifically
  - b) The difference between a living thing and a non-living thing is due to something **natural** some property or capability which can be explained scientifically

#### **Non-living Things**




Non-living things are created by living things (or other natural events)

Living things create themselves from other living things!


#### Life = Self-creation & Self-maintenance




Life is the activity of a living thing to create its material existence from other living things and maintain that existence despite its hostile environment.


#### But if this is correct, then ...

- > Life has existed for all time ....!






Every living thing is a community of other living things
